

## **RULES for CCYF Educational Entry Contest**

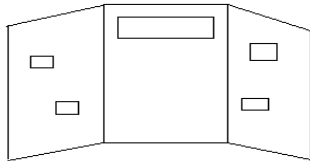
The fair board hopes to promote educational activities by both providing the youth member an opportunity to show what they have learned during their project and educate the general public about the time and dedication required to complete a project. Please read the rules carefully. This year the information is not in your fair book.

### **2 categories for entry: Educational Display or Educational Poster**

**Cash awards will be given to the top poster in each species and top display in each species. An overall Grand and Reserve Champion will be awarded in both the display and poster contests just before the auction Saturday night.**

Educational Display- Entry may be submitted by individual or family. Title of entry must be “*My 4-H or FFA \_\_\_\_\_ project.*”  
animal species

Entry should describe project from beginning (purchase) until Fair time. The entry should only cover one animal species that the exhibitor has entered in the fair. The display should include but is not limited to: pictures, captions for pictures, goals, and knowledge and skills gained as well as educational information about that animal species. The display category will have **4 feet** of space and will be a tri-fold unit as shown. It will sit on a table. It must not take up more than 4 feet of space when folded or be taller than 4 feet. See example:



Educational Poster- Entry should be the same as for a display but on a smaller scale. The entry will be a single regular sized poster board (22"X27.5"). Entry is limited to individuals and should represent the entire scope of the project.

***Entry forms are due December 3, 2010. Forms may be turned in at the County Extension Office or given to a fair board member by this date.***

**Entry fee is \$5 for a display entry and \$3 for a poster entry due with the entry form.**

*The Grand and Reserve Champion will not be a lot number in the auction sale but will be recognized before the auction begins.*
